

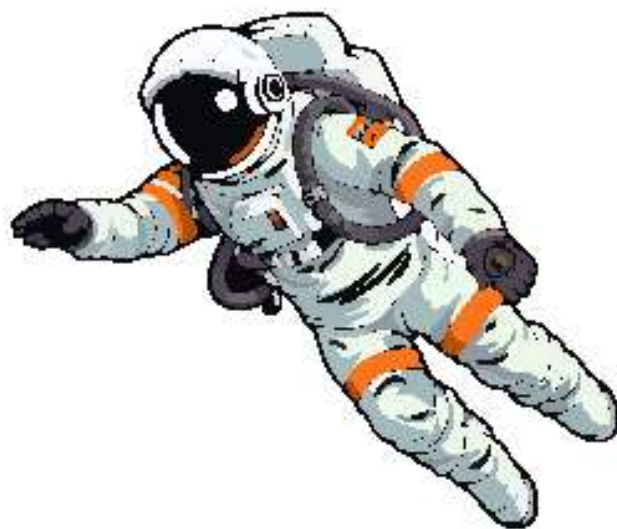

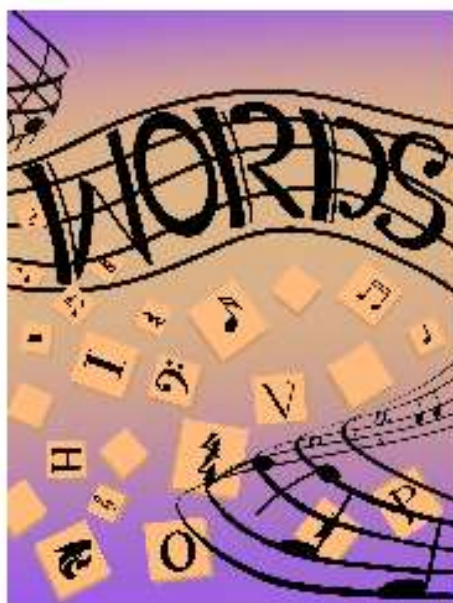

ACHIEVEMENTS

The EHS Marching Band has won the US Bands NJ State Championship for their group size in 14 of the past 22 seasons, including last season. The band has qualified for finals at the BOA Mid-Atlantic Regional in 2022 and 2023, placing 7th overall in 2022. The EHS Marching Band has also captured the US Bands National Championship for their group size in 2006, 2013, 2014, 2018, 2020 and 2022. The EHS Honors Wind Ensemble and Jazz Ensemble have both received "Superior" ratings at almost all festivals attended in the last 10 years. The Honors Wind Ensemble is routinely invited to perform at the NJ State Gala concert and the EHS Jazz Ensemble consistently placed within the top 5 at NJAJE State finals including 2nd place last year.

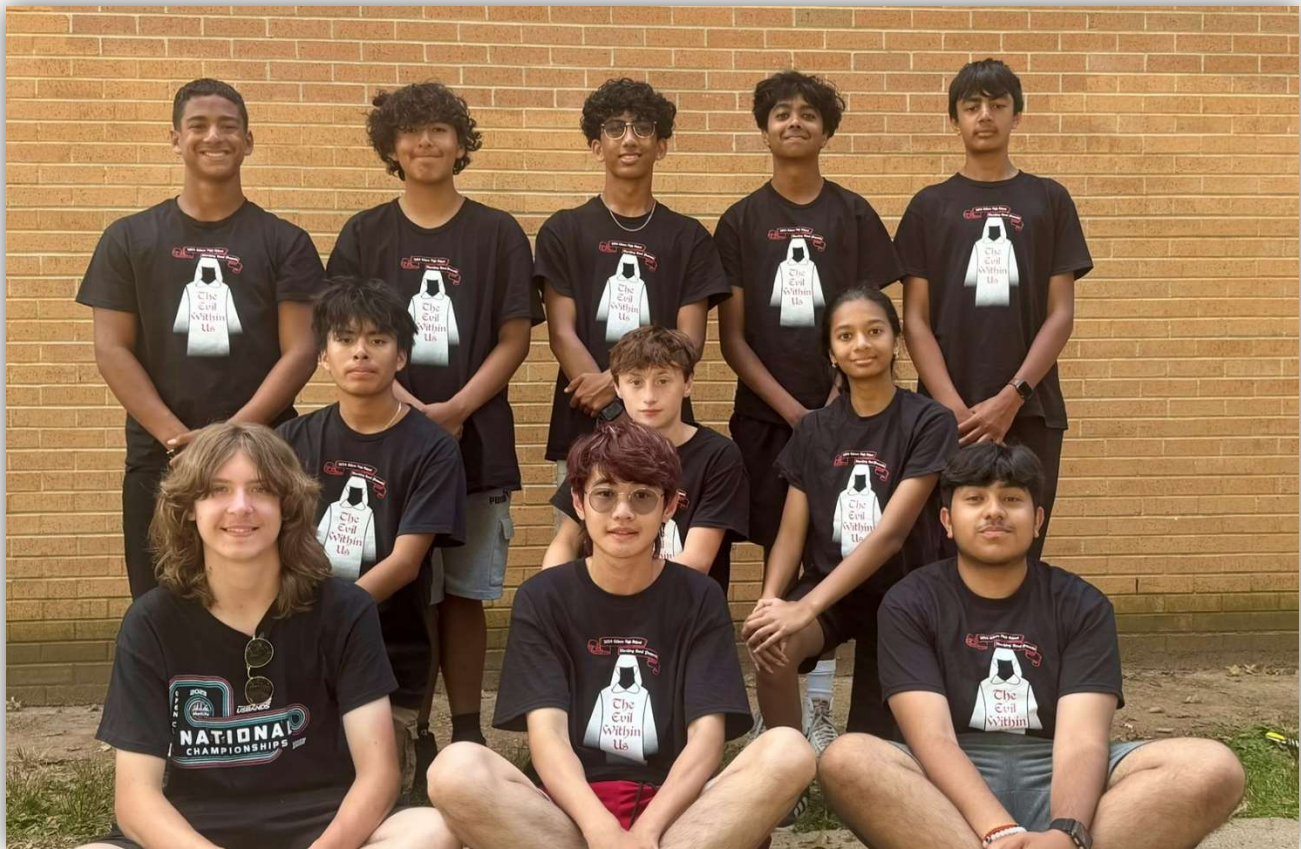
