### SPECTATOR INFORMATION

Parking: Spectator parking will be available in the lot across the street from the school.

**Tickets:** Tickets will be \$12 general admission, and \$8 for students and senior citizens. These can be purchased at the ticket booth outside of the stadium or you can also purchase in advance by sending payment via Venmo or PayPal (QR Codes below):

**Concessions:** Concessions will be available at the concession stand, adjacent to the field. We will be accepting payments in Cash, Venmo or PayPal

**Restrooms:** Portable restrooms are available inside the stadium. Additionally, restrooms inside the school will be available for use. Signs will be posted.











### **ENSEMBLE INFORMATION**

**Bus & Truck Parking:** See map below for bus parking and equipment trucks.

**Performer Restrooms:** Performers will have the opportunity to use restroom facilities inside the school, upon arrival.

**Warm Up:** Warm up areas will be available in the front of the school. In the map below where band drop off is indicated is where each ensemble will check in and be greeted by a guide to help them go from location to location.

**Field Surface:** The field is artificial turf, and will have high school hashes. No motorized vehicles are allowed on the field. **All golf carts, trailers, etc. are to remain on the track area only.** Fines may be incurred if your vehicle damages the turf field.

**Power on Field:** Power will be available at the front sideline near the 50 yard line.

**Medical/EMS:** We will have EMS coverage. They will be located in the dugout in the baseball field next to the concession stand. We will have visible signs and there will be an ambulance on site.

**Retreat:** Drum majors and ensemble captains should report to the flagpole area prior to the final performance to begin preparing for retreat.

**Hospitality:** Hospitality will be located in an outdoor location in a tent near the field. *No hospitality available for directors and staff members.* 

**Meet & Greet:** Meet and Greet with the Adjudicators and up to 5 ensemble staff will take place in the school choir room at the end of the competition. The choir room is next to the Director Check In as shown on the map below.

**Credentials:** All Ensemble staff and Chaperones should have a USBands Credential for entry into the stadium. Anyone without a credential will be asked to purchase a ticket. Directors, Staff, USBands Event Staff, and Adjudicators should have USBands Credentials in order to enter the Hospitality area.

**Competition Suite:** Adjudicator commentary for all USBands ensembles can be located in Competition Suite shortly after the conclusion of each ensemble's performance.



### WIRELESS FREQUENCY GUIDELINES FOR BANDS

To help keep the event running smoothly and prevent wireless interference, here's a quick overview of the wireless systems in use inside the stadium—and how your band can help make sure everyone has clear, reliable connectivity throughout the day.

Frequency	Purpose			
2.4 GHz	USBands Staff/Adjudicator WiFi			
5 GHz	USBands Staff/Adjudicator WiFi			

### 1. Run a Frequency Scan

If your wireless system supports it, run a frequency scan in the warm-up area before using your equipment. This helps identify open frequencies in real time.

### 2. Program Your Wireless System

After scanning, program your wireless mics, in-ears, or other devices to the appropriate frequencies.

### 3. Keep Transmitters On

Once your wireless is programmed, do not turn off the transmitters. You may change batteries as needed, but try to keep devices powered on. This helps other bands' scans detect your signals and avoid interference.

### 4. Power Off After Your Performance

As soon as your performance is finished, turn off all transmitters. This frees up those frequencies for the next band to use.

### **ACHIEVEMENTS**

The instrumental music program at Edison High School offers a comprehensive music program for all students involved. The EHS Marching Band has won the US Bands NJ State Championship for their group size in 14 of the past 23 seasons. The band has qualified for finals at the BOA Mid-Atlantic Regional in 2022 and 2023, placing 7th overall in 2022. The EHS Marching Band has also captured the US Bands National Championship for their group size in 2006, 2013, 2014, 2018, 2020 and 2022. The EHS Honors Wind Ensemble and Jazz Ensemble have both received "Superior" ratings at almost all festivals attended in the last 10 years. The Honors Wind Ensemble is routinely invited to perform at the NJ State Gala concert and the EHS Jazz Ensemble consistently placed within the top 5 at NJAJE State finals including 2nd place in 2024.



The THSMB has won the USBands New York State Championship in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2018, 2023, and 2024. They were the USBands National Championship Silver Medalists in 2024.
